We are your children, give us bread today.

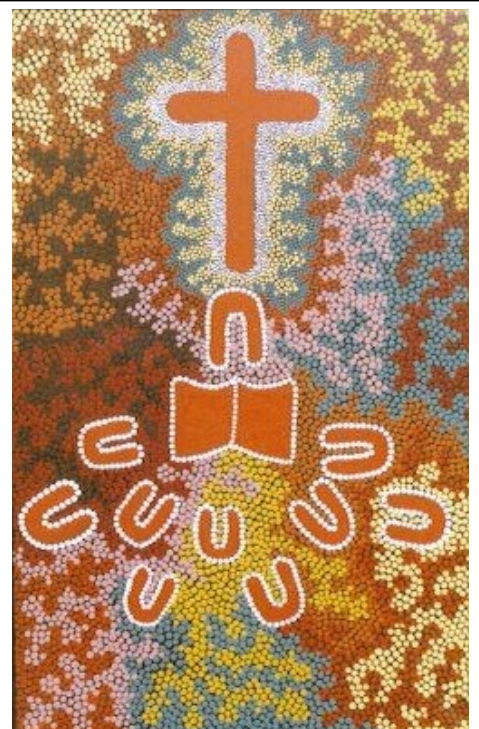
We have done wrong, we are sorry,
