remind us of the wonder of your creation.

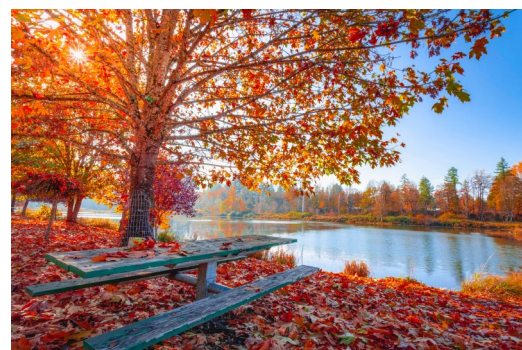
May the steam of our breath in the cool air
