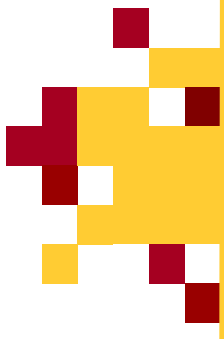

Wishing all families a very safe and happy holiday.

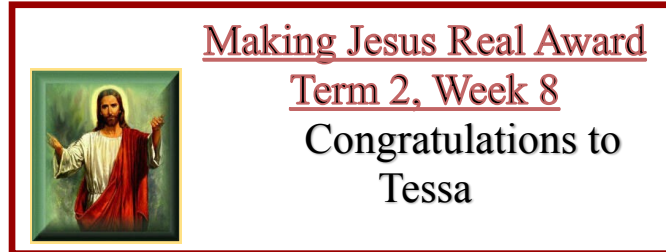
