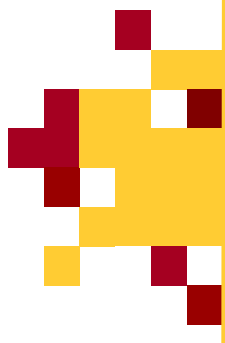

- The online orders will be open until **midnight on Sunday 7th of October 2018 - for the Bulk Pricing Offer**
 - **The Bulk Pricing Offer is \$20 per print and these will be delivered to the school BY CLASS GROUP**
 - After the \$20 pricing expires, the photos will remain available online, but the photos are now at a cost of \$35 per image and delivered to a preferred address.

HOW TO ORDER FROM YOUR SCHOOL CANTEEN



1. Brown Lunch Bags can be purchased from any Supermarket or the Canteen at 10c each.
2. Clearly write your Childs name and year on the front of bag
3. Select from Canteen Menu and write this plus the price on front of bag.
4. Place correct money into bag as no change can be given
5. Double check the price on front of bag matches what you have put inside.
6. Fold top over a couple of times to ensure money stays inside. Do not seal as this bag is used to put your Childs lunch into.
7. Put lunch bag into blue basket in Childs class room.
8. Canteen co-ordinator will collect baskets and prepare lunches
If no money is supplied with the Childs lunch order a vegemite sandwich will be provided in place of lunch ordered.
9. Just before bell rings for lunch, baskets are delivered back to class room for teacher to distribute to children who have ordered lunch.
10. Children enjoy their canteen prepared lunch
11. Icy poles, Icecreams and Milkshakes are purchased after lunch direct from canteen, therefore students require extra money for these items.

Dear Parents,

We are very pleased to have parents already register for our MYSCHOOLCONNECT app and also already place orders for both the canteen and the uniform shop.

Here are a few FAQ about the new app and process:

How can I download the app?

Simply go to your app store and search - myschoolconnect

How do I pay for my order?

You will have the option to pay with an online wallet (deposit money into your MySchool Connect wallet) or you can also pay via PayPal or credit card.

Do I need to send in a paper bag?

No, paper bags are supplied by the canteen for online orders.

Are there any fees?

Myschool Connect have a 33cent fee per order.

Online Wallet - there is no extra charge to pay with money deposited into your online wallet.

Credit Card - 1.9%

PayPal - 2.9%

Why is there a 33cent charge?

This particular app was free for us to set up. With the only charge being the 33cents per order taken by myschoolconnect. With a small school and our canteen and uniform shop 1 day per week. This option made more sense.

Can I still order with cash?

Yes, the traditional way of ordering for canteen is also still available.

Can we order lunch online and still give children cash for recess and second lunch bell?

Absolutely. You can also order your recess and after lunch snacks. Both options are available.

What time can I place my order?

Ordering for canteen is open for each Monday all week. The cut off time is 9am on the MONDAY for that ordering day.

Uniform sizes

Uniform sizes will be available soon. Until then please write your child's sizes into the comments section on your order.

The option to order online or through the app is just another option for parents to purchase canteen, dinner meals and uniforms. Please note that the option to order with cash will always be available.
